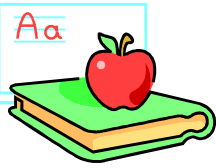


# Kindergarten News

## **In the first two weeks of school we will:**

- Read The Little School Bus and Fix It Mr. Duck
- we will learn to use centers and follow our center chart
- children will be introduced to our classroom computers
- practice rhyming words
- continue to write our names using one uppercase letter and the rest lowercase letters
- identify characters in a story
- identify upper and lowercase letters (A B C D E) ( a b c d e)
- children will practice counting words in sentences and counting letters in words.
- make bingo dabber name tags
- discuss the math terms: left, right, before after, between, same, different, inside, outside
- we will learn to name attributes of classroom objects

## **At Home**

- Practice rhyming words. Dictate three words to your child. Have your child tell you which two words rhyme.
- Read the I Am phonics book that will be sent home next week. Have your child practice pointing to each word as he/she reads the book to you.
- Have your child practice writing his/her name using one uppercase letter
