We are in week 5 of Unit 5 in Scott Foresman. These last few weeks before the benchmark test will focus on the remaining letter sounds of u,v,y,q, the sight words come, where, said, was, the comprehension skills plot, main idea, drawing conclusions, and the genres fantasy, informational text, and fiction. In grammar we will focus on nouns, and verbs. Unit 6 is a review of all short vowels, and all comprehension skills. We will learn to hear the long vowel sounds in words.

We are expanding our writing skills as we work on getting more details in our writing and upper case letters with periods/question marks in our sentences. You can see the excellent readers we have become when you listen to the Book Buddy Bag books!
