Here is a quick run down or the month:

The fifth grade artists are finishing their masks for Graduation. They are also mixing colors in a painting lesson Called "Sunday Morning Sun" using artist prints to get their color schemes. The fifth & fourth grade artists will be sharing an art project which involves the Mona Lisa by Leonardo De Vinci, in which, the artists will have to change the image to create their own Mona Lisa Parody.
