READING

We are currently working on the theme of Exploration in our reading books. We have read about exploring neighborhoods, nature, outer space, and desert habitats. We have one more story to read to complete our first unit. Following this unit will be a Benchmark Test and Fluency Assessment. These assessments will help us to see how your student is progressing and what your child needs to be successful.

MATH

We have just completed the Chapter 1 Test from the Math program. Most students seem to have a good understanding of skip- counting and looking for patterns. This chapter also tested their knowledge of graphs and their uses. Chapter 2 will begin to focus on Addition concepts such as; joining groups, counting on, number sentences, and turnaround facts.

I will be sending home Math Fact sheets starting next week to study for a weekly Mad Minute. Please help your child learn these facts. It is so important to their math success.

LANGUAGE

We are reviewing the basics in Grammar. We have worked on sentences, subjects, predicates and next we will review types of sentences. When checking your child's homework, please look for capitals, end marks and noticing if the sentences make sense. Encourage them to check their own work before showing it to you.

SCIENCE

You should have seen a notice that went home about our Desert Animal Habitats project. This will include our research on the chosen animal, a written report (done in school), and a Diorama to be constructed at home. Students will present the project to the class. The diorama is due Oct. 13th. If you have any questions or concerns please contact me.
