

Classroom Discipline Plan:

It is important to create an environment where students feel safe and are able to reach their greatest potential. In order to achieve this goal students are asked to create and agree to a list of classroom rules. Enforcing rules and maintaining specific expectations will allow students to enjoy learning. Each student will have their name written on a clothespin that is attached to a green clipboard. If a student is redirected more than one time, their name clip will be removed and placed on the yellow or red clipboard.

If a student chooses to break a class rule, the following actions will take place:

First redirection : Warning (clothespin will remain on green)

Second redirection: Clip will be moved to yellow

Third redirection: Clip is moved to red and student will be asked to write a note to their parent about their behavior. Student will be required to work separately from their group.

Fourth redirection: Principal's office

At the end of *each* day student names will return back to green clipboard. Behavior problems will be recorded on a checklist for conduct grades at the end of the quarter. Parents will be informed of any serious conduct problems through email, a note home, or a phone call.

If a student's clip remains on the green for the entire week, they will earn a ticket for the week. There will be a raffle monthly for the eligible students. Any student who remains on the green each quarter will earn a "no homework pass."
