Dear Parents,

Welcome to the 2009-2010 school year! I have put together the following information that I think will be useful to you as we begin the school year.

DAILY PAPERS – Your child will be bringing home daily work as well as office memos, newsletters and such. Please check your child's papers daily. This way you will know if there are any important school happenings coming up. Also by simply checking your child's papers you will get an idea of the skills we are covering and let you know of any areas where he/she may need extra practice.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION – We have begun a 7 day rotating specialist schedule. The days are labeled d “**A-G**”. Today began as day “A” and it will consistently rotate through the letters. This year we will have physical education on **days “E & G”**. Please have your child wear sneakers and comfortable clothes on gym day. I will try to remind them the day before to wear sneakers.

SUPPLIES - I am asking for donations for the classroom. Through out the year, we will always need **tissues**, small sandwich size **zip-lock** baggies, **glue sticks**, **paper towels** and **purell**. I will be sending home a volunteer sign up sheet in the next few weeks. LUNCH – School lunch **costs \$2.00** and milk is .50c. Children are to take care of their own money. Please put their money in an envelope, wrist pouch, wallet, etc. Money should not be brought to school in pockets or loose in backpacks. The children tend to play with loose change, drop money or lose their “ice cream money” if it is not in some sort of container. Children may also purchase a five-day lunch ticket, which the cafeteria staff holds for the child. Lunches do not have to be purchased consecutively.
