

## Classroom Rules 2009



After discussing why rules and laws are important in the world, the students decided that the following rules would help make our classroom a better place to play, learn and grow together.

1. Keep our hands and feet to ourselves.
2. Respect each other! Listen and pay attention when others are talking.
3. Be a PeaceBuilder! Try to work out problems before you talk to an adult.
4. Be responsible! Do our work neatly and carefully. Take care of our class and our materials.
5. Use quiet voices and walking feet.
6. Always try our best!

### Consequences

Students will earn stickers for following classroom rules, exhibiting PeaceBuilder behavior and participating in class. Praise cards and rewards may also be given.

Completing a month's homework assignments neatly and carefully will earn a homework pass.

Students also have behavior charts. Everyone starts the day on green. Students who do not follow the rules may be asked to change their card. Yellow is a warning. Blue results in loss of five minutes of recess. Orange cards mean the student will lose recess for the day. Finally, a red card means that your child will complete a "ticket" which will need to be signed.

Finally, physical or emotional bullying will not be tolerated and will result in a visit to Mrs. Lucas. Once again, the student will need to write a note to you, as well as an apology to the student.

A weekly calendar will be sent home on Friday's for your signature. The calendar should be returned every Monday.
