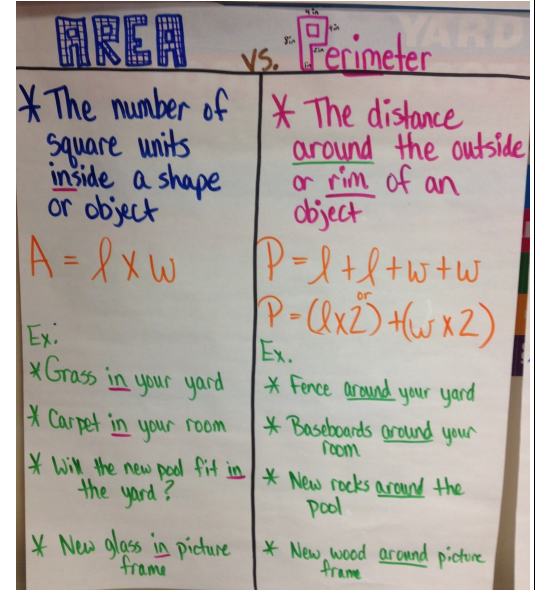

**If you need assistance with the weekly Math task:**


Follow the instructions on the sheet.  
Choose 5 vegetables and calculate the area and perimeter of each.

**Example:**

Peas 3 inches length & 4 in. width

Area =  $L \times W$ , so  $3 \times 4 = 12$  square in.

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Perimeter} &= (2 \times L) + (2 \times W) \\ &= (2 \times 3) + (2 \times 4) \\ &= 6 + 8 = 14 \text{ in.} \end{aligned}$$

Click on the speaker in the left hand column to listen to the passage.</b></li> <li>• <b>Choose <u>ONE</u> of the five plants from the article that you are most interested in.</b></li> <li>• <b>Draw a picture of the plant in your notebook. Make sure to label all of its parts, including its leaves, stems or branches, flowers, and roots.</b></li> <li>• <b>Then write a short description of what your plant looks like and how you think it stays alive.</b></li> </ul>
