Negative behavior in the art room.

Two marks- The student's name is spoken and the child is moved to an empty table to stop behavior.

Three marks- The student is then asked to come in for recess or after school and fill out a behavior sheet which goes home for a guardian to sign.

Positive behavior in the art room.

If the class as a whole comes in quietly, works during the class and cleans their tables, the class will receive a sticker on the star chart. When they reach eight stickers, the class earns a free choice in art. They can choose any art related fun activity.
