

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION 2024

Fairhaven Public Schools Registration Information 2024-2025 Academic Year

Children who are expected to enter **Kindergarten or First Grade** in the *Fairhaven Public Schools* next September can register starting March 8, 2024. Registration is an online process. You can follow the online ([directions](#)) or click here to read them on the district website ([website](#)). If you need assistance with online registration, you can visit your neighborhood school from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm on the following days:

Tuesday, March 19, 2024	Last Name: A - J
Wednesday, March 20, 2024	Last Name: K - R
Thursday, March 21, 2024	Last Name: S - Z

If you can't make it this week, you can call the school and make an appointment.

Entrance age Kindergarten: Any child, resident of Fairhaven, who turns age five (5) on or before **August 31, 2024, is eligible to register for Kindergarten.**

Entrance age First Grade: Any child, resident of Fairhaven, who is six (6) years of age on or before **August 31, 2024, is eligible for first grade.**

Children already attending Kindergarten in the Fairhaven Public Schools do not need to register for first grade. Children already attending Preschool in the Fairhaven Public Schools will need to register under RETURNING STUDENTS.

The following documents will need to be uploaded for the registration process:

Birth Certificate

Immunization Records & Physical from within one year

Proof of Residency

- **A. If you own your home:** A mortgage or tax bill in your name; a copy of a recent bill (cable, house phone bill, electricity, etc.) in your name; copies of both custodial parents' licenses.
- **B. If you rent from a Landlord:** A notarized Landlord affidavit and a mortgage or tax bill in the landlord's name; a copy of a recent bill (cable, house phone bill, electricity, etc.) in your name; copies of both custodial parents' licenses. A landlord affidavit can be found on the district website or at your neighborhood school.
- **C. If you live with someone:** A notarized Resident affidavit and a mortgage or tax bill in the owner's name; a copy of a recent bill (cable, house phone bill, electricity, etc.) in your name; copies of both custodial parents' licenses. A resident affidavit can be found on the district website or at your neighborhood school.

Certified copy of probate court order or judgment relative to the custody of the child. In the event of a restraining order or other legal decree, please ensure that up-to-date information is on file in the school office.
