

NAMING/RENAMING SCHOOL FACILITIES

1:0 POLICY PURPOSE

1:1 This policy serves to provide the Fairhaven School Committee with a formal mechanism to name schools, grounds, and rooms in school buildings.

2:0 CONDITIONS

2:1 The School Committee may exercise its discretion in naming new schools constructed by the Town and, as well as renaming existing schools, rooms, or grounds.

3:0 PROCEDURES

The Superintendent of Schools will form a Selection Committee composed of a School Committee member, the Superintendent, a system administrator, a representative of the Teachers Association, a student, a community member, and a member of the Board of Selectmen. The Selection Committee will receive testimony from nominating groups and make a recommendation to the School Committee based upon established criteria.

Three criteria for selection include: (1) having Town residency or former residency (2) making a significant contribution to education in Fairhaven, (3) having tangible connection with the contribution of the individual to the facility.
